I. PURPOSE

This is the transmittal of the revised tables for income guidelines. The tables are used for determining the status of Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) income eligibility.

revised tables which are available in the [WIOA ePolicy](#) Manual on the Illinois workNet website.

IV. COMPONENTS

Effective for applications taken on or after May 15, 2023, the attached income guidelines for determining low-income status, commonly referred to as the 70% Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL), are to be used to determine eligibility.

V. ACTION REQUIRED

The attached tables should be disseminated immediately to all entities responsible for determining eligibility. The attachments of this notice should replace those found in WIOA Notice No. 21-NOT-04.


